

CLINICAL ACTIVITY

Collaborative activity of KSMU and medical organizations of Karaganda region is carried out based on the following regulatory legal acts:

The agreements between MH and KSMU

Karaganda State Medical University concluded agreements with 55 medical organizations of Karaganda region, rendering:

- Inpatient care – 27;

- Obstetric and gynecologic care (maternity hospitals) – 4;
- Emergency care – 2.
- Forensic medical examination – 1.

- Regional Children's Sanatorium – 1.

The heads of departments, professors, associate professors of the clinical departments hold morning conferences of doctors and planned doctor's rounds in hospital departments; consult a difficult diagnostic challenge in patients of both profile and non-profile departments (if required); perform surgery; arrange seminars for doctors; hold pathologoanatomic and clinical conferences and medical consultations; review clinical records, out-patient's cards, reports of doctors; speak as opponents at pathologoanatomic conferences; provide introduction of science achievements into practice.

The number of the study rooms at the clinical sites is 389, the total area of 8185.15 sq.m.

At the clinical sites is carried out diagnostic, treatment-and-consultation work by 343 teachers.

Of them: 41.40% of doctors with higher category, 12.83% with first category, 8.16% with second category; 37.61% of staff members have professional certificate without any category.
